Rules for Visitors

In the interests of communal comfort and harmony, the Warden has been instructed by the Committee of the Society to enforce the following rules:

1. MEALS

Except in special circumstances, to be agreed with the Warden, meals can only be cooked and eaten between the following times:

Breakfast

7.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m.

Lunch

12.00 noon to 2.00 p.m.

Tea

5.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

Dinner

7.00 p.m. to 8.30 p.m.

Members *must* see that all utensils used in both cooking and consuming their meals are washed and put away immediately a meal is finished.

2. GENERAL HYGIENE

Visitors will be assigned by the Warden to a rota each week for jobs such as sweeping floors, scrubbing tables, fetching water, disposing of waste, etc.

3. TIDINESS

Personal belongings, books, instruments, collected material, etc., must not be left lying about in the living room.

Bedrooms must be kept tidy and swept regularly.

Before leaving, members must make sure that no personal litter has been left for someone else to dispose of.

4. QUIET AT NIGHT

People's sleeping needs and habits vary widely. Quiet must therefore be the rule after 10.30 p.m. and the living room must be clear by midnight.

5. GENERAL MATTERS

The attendance book must be signed as directed by the Warden.

Fees, at the rates in force at the time, must be paid to the Warden before departure.

6. RECORDS

The Society exists to study and further the conservation of the natural features of Lundy. It is one of the Warden's duties to write a daily log of observations made on the Island. Please contribute to this as much as possible.

Any long-term observations made as a result of your stay should be carefully written up and annotated and offered for publication to the Editor of the Annual Report.

Visitors are reminded that any publication elsewhere than in the Report, whether in print or by broadcast, must be submitted beforehand to the Secretary.

It will be appreciated if copies of any unusual photographs taken on the Island are deposited with the Secretary.
