BIRD RINGING IN 1989

Ringers were on the island for five weeks in spring, one in July and five in the autumn. With less September coverage than usual, autumn totals were unexceptional but very good spring numbers brought the year's ringing total to 3430. The Willow Warbler total was a record 897, caught mainly in spring. It was almost matched by the 842 Goldcrests - a total which, though a little lower than in 1987 and 1988, was still far in excess of the annual average of about 100. Other numerous species included Swallow (though lower than in the previous two years), Sedge Warbler and Whitethroat, both with exceptionally high spring totals, Meadow Pipit, Blackcap and Chiffchaff (the latter lower than in the previous three years).

Olive-backed Pipit was added to the Lundy ringing list. Other unusual species ringed included Corncrake, Barred Warbler, two Red-backed Shrikes, Woodchat Shrike and Ortolan Bunting.

Following the previous year's two Turtle Doves ringed, 1989 produced a further three, out of a grand total of only eleven since 1947. The two Snow Buntings caught brought their grand total to eight. Though Melodious and Yellow-browed Warblers are scarce in Britain, their totals were raised to twenty-five and thirty-one respectively, while, despite their commoner British status, the three Wood Warblers caught brought their total to twenty-five also. The twelve Lesser Whitethroats ringed were, like the Sedge Warblers and Whitethroats, an exceptional feature of the spring catches. An autumn netting session on the Landing Beach produced the third Lundy-ringed Turnstone, and seven Rock Pipits to add to the previous total of six.

A complete list of the 1989 ringing totals is given below, together with total numbers for all species since ringing started in 1947. A Goldcrest caught on 15th October took the total of birds ringed on Lundy past the 50,000 mark.

Recoveries and controls during the year included a Storm Petrel from Ireland, a Blackbird shot in France and a Sedge Warbler controlled there, three Willow Warblers involved in British west coast movements and a Goldcrest ringed on the Scillies which reached Lundy the following day. A complete list of recoveries and controls is given below.
