OTHER INVERTEBRATERECORDS ON LUNDY, 1992.

By-the-wind-sailor *Vellella spirans* (Forsk.) - about 3,000 were reported washed up on the south beach at Hell's Gates on 6.9.92.
Common Darter *Sympetrum striolatum* (Charp.) - recorded from 18.5.92 to 20.9.92 with a maximum of fifty on one day.
Broad-bodied dragonfly sp. - one on 14.6.92.
Common Blue Damselfly *Enallagma cyathigerum* (Charp.) - recorded from 14.6.92 to 28.8.92 with a maximum of 100 on one day.
Blue-tailed Damselfly *Ischnura elegans* (van der Linden) - twenty on 14.6.92.
Common Field Grasshopper *Chorthippus brunneus* (Thunb.) - two on 13.10.92.
Green Tiger Beetle *Cicindela campestris* (L.) - one on 26.4.92.
Minotaur Beetle *Typhaeus typhoeus* (L.) - records from 7.3.92 to 5.11.92 with a maximum of twenty-five recorded on one day.
Dor Beetle *Geotrupes stercorarius* (L.) - one on 28.4.92 and two on 1.5.92.
Rosechafer *Cetonia aurata* (L.) - recorded from 14.6.92 to 21.7.92 with a maximum of two on one day.

Staphylinus dimidiaticornis Gemm. Airfield and Quarterwall Pond. This species has not been recorded previously. The closely related *S.erythropterus* L. has been recorded and has been confirmed (Brendell, M., 1976, *Ann, Rep.LFS*, 29-53).
Geotrupes stercorarius (L.) Halfway Wall.
Typhaeus typhoeus (L.) frequent, Quarterwall to Middle Park.

Aphodius granarius (L.) Airfield. This species has not been recorded previously.
Byrrhus pilula (L.) two sites by Halfway Wall, east.
Dryops lurida (Erich.) vegetational debris at water's edge, Pondsbury.
Micrambe vini (Panz.) Halfway Wall.
Cylindronotus laevioctostriatus (Goeze) Halfway Wall.
Lochmaea suturalis (Thoms.) frequent, south-east quarter.

MAMMALS ON LUNDY, 1992

Pygmy Shrew, *Sorex minutus* - sightings of single shrews from 9.2.92 to 4.10.92
Bat sp. probably Pipistrelle Bat *Pipistrellus pipistrellus* - one on 19.9.92.
Common Long-eared Bat *Plecotus auritus* - one found dead on 13.7.92
Rabbit *Oryctolagus cuniculus* - the only count was 200 from the Devil's Slide to North Light on 19.5.92. Comments in the Log about how few rabbits were around from mid June onwards.
Brown Rat *Rattus norvegicus* - present, no counts recorded.
Black Rat *Rattus rattus* - sighting of one on 28.10.92
Grey Seal *Halichoerus grypus* - largest recorded numbers were fifty-nine on 6.2.92, seventy-one on 6.5.92. Pups were recorded at Brazen Ward (one on 6.6.92), Gannets' Bay (five on 4.9.92), the Landing Bay (one on 8.10.92) and off north end (one on 12.10.92).
Soay Sheep *Ovis aries* - the only full count recorded was 114 on 8.10.92 (eighty-eight female, thirteen male and thirteen young).
Goat *Capra hircus* - the largest number of wild goat recorded was six.
Sika Deer *Cervus nippon* - the highest recorded number was fourteen on 19.4.92 (three male, seven female and four kids).
Common Dolphin *Delphinus delphis* - single sightings on 14.1.92 and 26.2.92.
Cetacean sp. - one on 28.4.92.

OTHER VERTEBRATE RECORDS ON LUNDY, 1992

Basking Shark *Cetorhinus maximus* - single sightings on 11.6.92 and on three days in August.
Shark sp. - seen on 27.7.92 (8-10 feet long), 11.8.92 and 17.8.92.
