INTRODUCTION

Ringing coverage involved two weeks of work on migrants in spring, one in August and two in September and October. In June and July, John Hutchinson continued his Skylark studies and small numbers of seabirds were ringed.

2259 birds of forty-seven species were ringed in the year. As in 1999, the highest total was for Willow Warblers, and the figures for most other regular species were similar too, with Sedge Warbler, Blackcap, Chiffchaff and Goldcrest totals again reaching three figures. However, much greater effort was put into catching Swallows in 2000, so that their numbers pushed Chaffinches down into third place. Other differences include a pleasingly high total for Whitethroats, perhaps reflecting better conditions in their wintering areas in Africa; and less emphasis on seabird ringing. The most unusual catches were a Melodious Warbler in August and Red-eyed Vireo and Redbreasted Flycatcher in October. A full list of the species totals is given below.

Among the details of the recoveries and controls received during the year, listed below, are exchanges of Sedge Warblers with both Dorset and Finistere, and a Chiffchaff and Willow Warbler making very similar spring movements from Portland to Lundy. Lesser Black-backed Gulls colour-ringed as pulli on Lundy have been seen in Spain, Portugal and France.

INTRODUCTION

Ringers were working on the island for two weeks in spring and four and a half weeks in autumn.

1336 birds of forty-two species were ringed in the year. Compared with the 2000 migration seasons, spring catches, involving species such as Sedge Warbler, Chiffchaff and Willow Warbler, were lower but in late autumn the totals for Robins, thrushes, Blackcaps and Chaffinches were higher. Siskins returned, after none were ringed in 2000, presumably having had a more productive breeding season. Goldcrest numbers were low but, in contrast, the total of seven Firecrests was above average. Unusual species ringed included Yellow-browed Warbler, Red-breasted Flycatcher, Golden Oriole and Scarlet Rosefinch. A full list of the species totals is given below.

Details of the recoveries and controls received during the year are also given below. With previously very limited knowledge of where Lundy's autumn migrant Chaffinches spend the winter, two found in England in December are of interest. Sedge Warblers have continued to show movements between Lundy and France, and details arrived of one that had come from Spain. A Song Thrush migrating via Lundy in autumn was also found in Spain. A Lesser Black-backed Gull, ringed as a pullus on Lundy, was seen in Portugal well enough for its individual ring number to be read in the field.
